

Page Dairy building target of arsonist

Arson was the cause of a blaze Tuesday night in the vacant Page Dairy Co. building, fire investigators said yesterday.

Fire Lt. Bill Johnson said police crews spotted flames shooting from the roof of the building about 11:40 p.m. Several small fires were set inside the building, investigators said. No one was injured, and no suspects have been identified.. *NOV. 10, 1994*

The building, at Wade and Williams streets, was closed in 1975 and has been a target of vandals for years. Investigators said homeless people are known to take shelter inside. *Blade*

U.S. Rep. Marcy Kaptur (D., Toledo) and Jolene Molitoris, federal railroad administrator, held a news conference Nov. 1 to announce the building will be razed. Because of a mixup in the bidding procedure, however, the demolition was delayed until next week.
